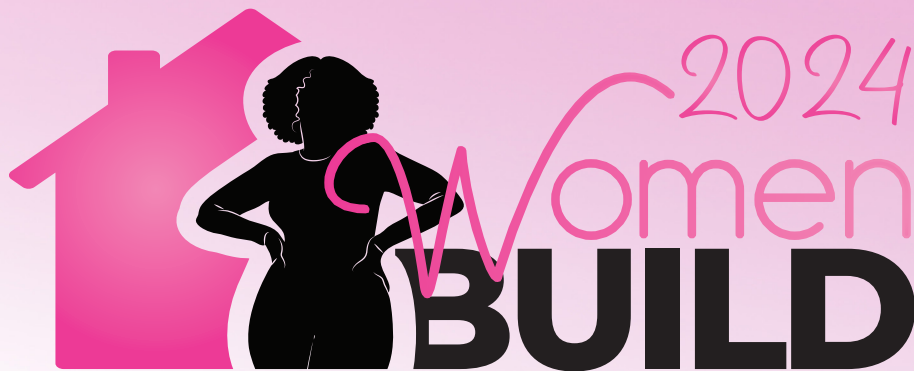

Wichita Habitat for Humanity (WHFH) is a non-profit Christian organization that brings people together to build homes, communities, and hope. We provide affordable homeownership opportunities for low to moderate income families, as well as home preservation to income-qualified families, seniors, and veterans.

WHFH stands alongside our neighbors in Sedgwick County, building not just homes, but opportunities. Through construction projects, repairs, and community initiatives, we impact hundreds of lives each year, removing barriers to affordable housing.

We offer a hand up, particularly for women and families facing challenging circumstances, because we believe everyone deserves a safe and stable place to call home. This is not possible without the unwavering support of our community, the hands that help build, the hearts that give, and the voices that champion our cause.

Why Women Build?

Indaka Warren isn't just building a house; she's laying the foundation for a childhood bathed in stability and joy. As a young, determined mother, Indaka's heart beats for her son, Elijah. Diagnosed with autism, Elijah struggles with the anxieties of change. These challenges echo Indaka's own childhood experiences—limited space, shared resources, and constant moves.

However, a transformative shift is underway through this year's Women Build, as Indaka partners with Wichita Habitat for Humanity to provide a future home for Elijah. A permanent residence where she and her family can call home. She will

no longer have to worry about shared spaces and rearranged belongings. This will be a home where Elijah can play freely in the backyard, under the open sky, with his favorite toys, and a home where Indaka has a sense of relief from the stability of homeownership.

So, meet Indaka, a woman whose strength is woven from love, whose resilience is etched in every step she takes.
